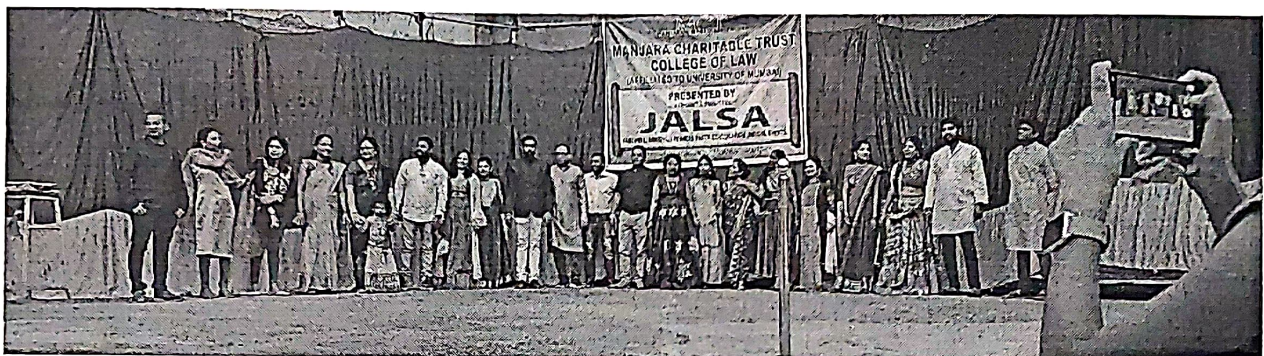

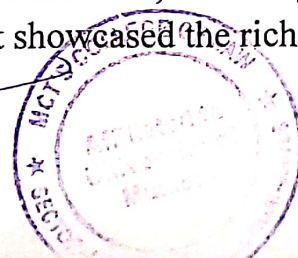


Navratri festival celebration at MCT College of law; “A vibrant Tapestry of culture and Dance”

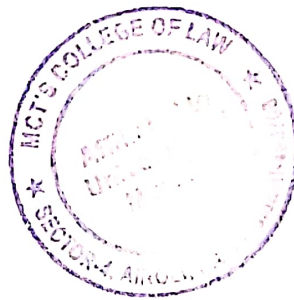


“Remembering the Heroes of Kargil on Vijay Diwas – A salute from our college”
